SHIRE OF BEVERLEY PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Vincent Street Streetscape Project

Following the public consultation sessions, GHD Consultants have now completed tender ready civil engineering and landscaping designs. Western Power Corporation is aiming to complete the undergrounding of power designs by end January 2021. At this stage undergrounding of power construction is scheduled to commence in May 2021 with civil construction activities (roadworks, footpath upgrading & landscaping), to commence in August/September 2021. Individually affected businesses and property owners in Vincent Street will be contacted in regards to the above as more information becomes available.

Moort Wabiny Park

The Official Opening will be 9:30am Friday 12 February 2021. The Community is invited, please RSVP to the Shire Office if you wish to attend. The entry statement is almost complete with fencing and lighting to be finished prior to the opening.

Containers for Change

A quick reminder that the Containers for Change program is not administered by the Shire of Beverley and abuse of Shire Staff when the pick-up is full is inappropriate. Obviously the program is being very well supported in the regions so please be patient as the operators sort out teething issues.

Bridge 3197 – York Williams Road

Bridge 3197 on York Williams Road has recently undergone emergency repairs and has been propped. Shire staff are seeking urgent grant funding to undertake the required construction work which is expected to be several million dollars. The detailed design work is complete and approved by Main Roads.

Reconciliation Action Plan

Council will consider the Terms of Reference for Reconciliation Action Plan Working Group at the February Council meeting. Public invitation to join the Working Group will be advertised after the meeting.

LRCI Funding Updates

The Town Hall flooring is now finished. Upgrades to the Town Hall entrance doors and floors are expected during February and March. The Gymnasium swipe card access will be installed early February. Work is also set to commence on the Lesser Hall Courtyard mid to late February.

Council meetings are held on the 4th Tuesday of the month, with the first one for 2021 being Tuesday 23 February. They start at 3pm in Council Chambers. Due to COVID-19 safe practise the number of visitors may be restricted. New year, new wasp season!

February 2021



The annual hunt to detect and eradicate European wasps (*Vespula germanica*) from WA is underway!

Guard your BBQs, monitor your pet's food and check the insects you scoop from the pool! European wasps, we are looking for you!

The European wasp is a declared pest and must be reported. It has threatened to establish in WA since six nests were found and destroyed near Fremantle in 1977, but thanks to ongoing collaborative surveillance between the Department, community, local governments and business, WA has prevented their permanent establishment and spread to date.

Widely established across most of southern Australia, these 'cane toads of the South' hitchhike their way into WA each year, and this is the 44th year spent competing in a sophisticated game of 'hide and seek' against this highly adaptable and dangerous pest.

Most detections are made in the Perth Metro but regional detections have included Geraldton, Kalbarri, Australind, Busselton, Donnybrook, Hyder and Albany.

Know what to look for

Unlike the widespread and similar looking black and yellow paper wasp, European wasps:

- **Scavenge** on human and pet food.
- **Feed on fruit** like grapes and stone fruit.
- **Nest underground** - nests grow to the size of a basketball in a single season and have a small (golf ball sized) entrance hole.
- Have completely **black antenna**.
- Do **NOT** dangle their legs when flying.
- Did we mention they'll eat your food?!

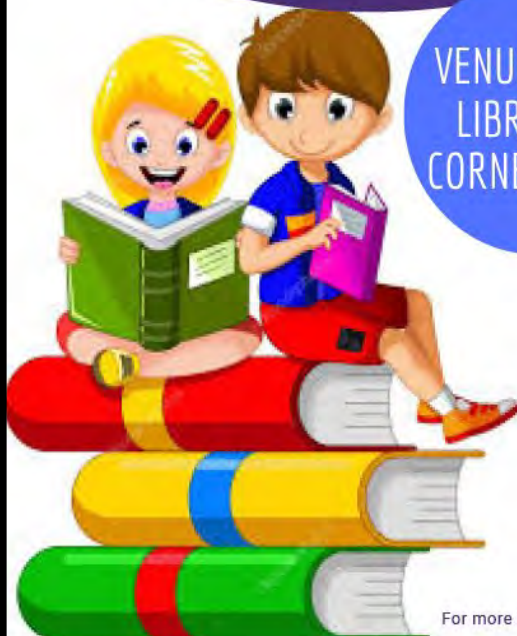

Dealing with conflict – Is it as simple as having a little empathy?

How often are we in conflict with someone? Conflict can often bring up a broad range of emotions like fear and anger and even the word is often used to describe war or the clashing of opposed interests.

Some conflict is a normal part of any healthy relationship, after all we cannot expect two people to completely agree on the same thing all the time. The saying “*let us agree to disagree*” is not always as simple as it sounds as often conflict is either avoided or not managed in a healthy way. This often can cause a great deal of harm and emotional pain in our relationships brought about by negative behaviors and feelings such as resentment, manipulation, abuse and/or control.

We can experience conflict within our personal relationships, family, workplace, schools or even within ourselves. I think in times of change, uncertainty and being out of our comfort zone (such as the effects of COVID-19) conflict can be exacerbated. Often what is a simple disagreement or misunderstanding can turn into a full-blown conflict as one or both parties perceive it as a threat or personal attack (whether real or not). So, it's important that we understand what causes and exacerbates conflict as this can depend on a whole range of factors:

- **Perception:** This is influenced by our life experiences, culture, values and beliefs. Do we respond to conflict based on our individual perception or an objective view of the facts?
- **Emotions:** If we are not aware of our emotions or have difficulty managing them in times of stress, trying to resolve conflict can be more difficult.
- **Avoidance:** Conflict continues to fester when not dealt with. Putting our head in the sand is one unhelpful coping strategy, self-medication (drinking more, working harder, talking less) is another.
- **Misunderstanding:** A lack of understanding about what others need or value can result in individuals not feeling heard or appreciated creating arguments and distance in relationships.
- **Communication breakdown:** This is worthy of another article in itself, but effective communication (both hearing and being heard) is vital for conflict resolution. Understanding the differences in male vs female communication styles is also important (not right or wrong but different!) When we are not coping in any area of our life, failure to communicate how we feel is one of our biggest mistakes. Remember communication is the start to the problem-solving process!

So how do we react or respond to conflict? Several well-known self-help websites talk about a healthy response to conflict which includes:

- Staying calm, non-defensive and being respectful.
- **Empathize** with the other person's viewpoint (Empathy = the ability to identify, understand and share the feelings of another).
- Seek compromise and not hold a grudge or seek to punish the other person.
- Forgive and forget (resentment is letting someone else live rent free in your head).
- Facing conflict and talking through issues is a chance for personal and relationship growth (not a point of difference about winning or losing).

It's important to understand that we are all unique individuals and the personal, environmental and lifestyle factors affecting our ability to cope with conflict are vast. However, with half of marriages ending in separation/divorce; bullying and harassment being major issues in schools/workplace; and the push for individualism outweighing collectivist values have we lost sight of one important attribute ... having a little more *Empathy* for one another?

A **Local Health Advisory Group** is a group of mostly local people [health consumers and professionals, carers, community members, guests from local healthcare groups, Shire Council delegates and service providers] who actively seek to improve health service planning, access, safety and quality within our community.

Beverley LHAG committee is affiliated with its local **Beverley Health Service** and meets bi-monthly at the Hospital. The Group consists of the above representatives including the Health Service Manager. *Membership is by application form only and may involve a screening process.* This is a non-financial group. The current Chairman is Mr Keith Murray.

Mr Murray is also the Beverley delegate, appointed by **WACHS [WA Country Health Service]** to represent Beverley at the **Western DHAC [District Health Advisory Committee]** which includes delegates from the Central Coast Region [Cervantes, Jurien], Bindoon, Moora, Dandaragan, Wongan Hills/Ballidu, Northam, Chittering, Goomalling & York.

Terms of Reference:

The Local Health Advisory Group will advise and support local health service providers in an environment of co-operation, shared understanding and consensus'

It is responsible for advising the Health Service Manager, District manager, Regional Director and District Health Advisory Council [DHAC]

District Health Advisory Council [DHAC] Forum held at Moora 21/10/2020 – attended by 4 Beverley LHAG committee. This was a most informative Forum where topics covered by speakers included-

1. An introduction to Wheatbelt Health staff including A/Regional Director Rachelle Ferrari, Operations Manager Trenton Greive
2. Care services covering Palliative, Cancer, Renal, Maternity and Community care
3. Mental Health Services dealing with moderate to severe cases
4. Covid 19 – it was noted there is a need for better communication especially those without computer/phone
5. Patient Transport – Contract now owned by WACHS presently held by St John Ambulance
6. Aged Care issues, difficulties organising care packages in rural areas, Commonwealth Funding, and also included a report on Care Provider facilitator ‘Mable’.

NB “Mable” is an online app, where you can self- manage your care package ie choose your support people, days and times of your sessions and you agree on how much to pay

The Forum was a worthwhile meeting. There was a wide representation and a shared interest in focusing on having community health and communication. We have a better understanding of services available to us.

1. Issues include housing problems, mobile phone blackspot areas, seeking legal advice for residents of Beverley, Brookton, Pingelly, Northam and Meekatharra.
2. Thank you to various people and groups-
 - Steve Gollan and Shire staff for a good relationship for some 20+ years.
 - CRC staff (Sam, Amor, Zoe and Rodney) with our relationship going back 1 week since CRC was founded some 20+ years.
 - Beverley Hospital CEO Michelle, nurses and staff for medical assistance to our vollies, friends and myself on a personal level when I was extremely ill some months ago. Thank you.
3. Stress- Mal Roberts does not provide legal advice. He obtains info, help those facing hardship living in a shed or tent. Broken relations, especially where children of tender age are involved. We seek help through Share and Care (NGO) in town organise help to put food on the table for such needy cases and arrange for them to speak to pro bono lawyers. There are criteria such as one must prove hardship, be on Centrelink, homeless, no money in the bank or unemployed. Broken relationship, some end up destitute and those who can't speak for themselves. In other words, our service is for the needy cases.
4. Telcos- For well over 15 years, many residents have constant problems with signals (towers), landline, black spots. I have commented on these matters before and requested our former local MP Mrs Judi Moylan to help. She was informed that there are 5 black spots in Beverley. The mobile phone signal tower is owned by Telstra. Other Telcos lease use of the signals to gain reception. Our experience with Telcos. Signal problems, landline, over billing, unable to deliver. See Local MP.
5. I wrote to Mr Christian Porter regarding the issue that is causing mobile phone reception problem to many residents in a number of streets. I also requested for a second tower to be built or put in a reception booster in the tower and in the black spot areas. Included in my letter is my case- my house in Duffield St has had no mobile reception for the last 2 weeks and I have requested action to be taken against the new supplier. Will also be seeking legal action/advice on failure to comply with the service- which amounts to breach of contract.
6. Finally, I speak for many in our community but not for all residents. If you do have families request them to help solve or settle community concerns. I repeat- my role at BVCS is to help the needy and not the whole community. My work as a Justice of the Peace is always available to any member of the Beverley Community (Covid-19 laws apply).
Note- if any Telcos harass you for payment or make threats of recovery when they are at fault, report them urgently to the Telco Ombudsman and your local MP.
